Rank from 1-9	ART8	Art 8	Art 8 builds on foundational drawing skills with a focus on texture, perspective, and more advanced shading techniques. Students will explore how artists create the illusion of space, depth, and surface detail through one-point and two-point perspective, layered shading, and mixed-media approaches. Projects may include architectural sketches, textured studies, imaginative landscapes, and perspective-based compositions. Students will expand their technical skill while developing their own creative voice and confidence as visual artists.
	INMUS8	Band (Instrumental Music) 8	Join the band and experience the thrill of making music together! Whether you're picking up an instrument for the first time or honing your skills, this full-year course will help you develop technique, musicality, and teamwork. You'll play a variety of pieces, learn the fundamentals of reading music, and have opportunities to perform throughout the year. The school will help organize the rental of your instrument.
	CONST8	CTF Construction 8	Step into the woodworking shop to learn carpentry and design through hands-on projects. Students safely use hand and power tools to measure, build, and finish creative pieces while developing skills, confidence, and teamwork.
	DESNST8A	CTF Design Studies 8A	Cricut and 3D Printing - In this hands-on course, students will explore digital and 3D design by creating projects using tools like Canva, Cricut, and 3D printers. They will design and produce items such as keychains, vinyl decals, paper crafts, and custom 3D models. Through the design process, students will build skills in planning, problem-solving, prototyping, and safe equipment use while developing confidence in creating high-quality, personalized products.
	DESNST8B	CTF Design Studies 8B	Crochet - Let's get stitching! In this hands-on course, students will learn the basics of crochet, including how to hold a hook, start a chain, and create simple stitches. You'll learn to read beginner-friendly patterns and work toward making your own small projects like scrunchies, coasters, headbands and amigurumi.
	ENTINOV8	CTF Enterprise and Innovation 8	Turn ideas into action in Business & Entrepreneurship! This course introduces the fundamentals of business planning, marketing, financial literacy, and leadership. Learn how to develop creative business ideas, manage resources, and navigate real-world challenges. Whether you're interested in launching a start-up, understanding global markets, or honing problem-solving skills, this class empowers you to think like an entrepreneur. Ready to take the first step toward building your future?
	FOODS8	CTF Foods 8	In this hands-on course, students will start by learning the essentials of kitchen safety and food handling. Then, they will dive into international cooking, connecting their learning to the Grade 8 Social Studies curriculum. Students will explore the ingredients, techniques, and cultural traditions behind Italian, Mexican, and Japanese cuisine, all while building their confidence and skills in the kitchen.
	DRAMA8	Drama 8	After a shorter orientation than in previous years this class will concentrate on Acting and Improvisational theatre. Acting exercises will address things like using a character's objective (goal), choosing a status level for a character and shaping meaning using actions and translations. We will explore improvisational theatre and do a short technical theatre unit as well.
	ENVOTED8	Environmental and Outdoor Education 8	This is an active hands-on course where students will get a chance to investigate different outdoor activities. Students will also investigate the Alberta environment and their relationship to it. This course will emphasize risk assessment and decision making, both as an individual and as part of a group. We will endeavor to include off-site trips to complement this learning, and we will be taking our learning outside in all weather conditions.
